

# Crown Tournament of Vladimir and Petranella

## REQUIREMENTS FOR COMBATANTS AND CONSORTS

Per Northshield law and Corpora, all combatants and consorts must:

- Hold a valid membership on the day of the Royal Lists. Within ten business days after being declared victor in a Crown or Coronet Tourney, the Victor and Consort must present to the Kingdom Seneschal proof that their memberships are current through at least the end of the upcoming reign.
- Each competitor in a Royal Lists must be fighting for a prospective consort of the opposite gender.
- No one may take part in a Royal Lists, either as a competitor or as a prospective consort, who has any reason to believe that either member of that competing couple will be unable to fulfill the duties of royalty.
- Each competitor and consort must have access to the appropriate corporate newsletter at their place of residence.
- Each competitor and consort must have read Corpora of the Society for Creative Anachronism and the laws of the Kingdom of Northshield.
- Each must have been a subject of Northshield for one year immediately before the Crown Tournament and be able to demonstrate a reasonable level of participation in diverse activities in Northshield during that period.
- All prospective combatants and consorts must be acceptable to the Presiding Royalty.
- No one under 18 years old may fight or be fought for in a Crown Tournament.
- No member of the Royalty may either fight or be fought for in a Crown Tournament.

In addition, and as allowed by Northshield law and tradition, Their Highnesses have the following additional requirements:

- All combatants and consorts must have an AoA-level or higher award
- All combatants and consorts must have held an office

## LETTERS OF INTENT TO COMPETE

Letters of Intent should be sent to Their Highnesses and the Kingdom Seneschal, and include:

- Full contact information
- Current membership numbers and expiration dates
- Office(s) held, group, and dates held

Additionally Their Highnesses must receive a clear electronic image of the arms you will be fighting under, prior to Coronation.

Letters of Intent must be received by midnight following Coronation (Saturday evening). Letters of Intent may be sent via email or postal mail. Addresses for Their Highnesses and Kingdom Seneschal are inside the front cover of the Northwatch and on the Northshield website (<http://www.northshield.org>).

On the day of the tournament, please be prepared to show the Kingdom Seneschal your membership card and Northwatch containing your pre-printed mailing address.

## TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Precedence for the tournament will be determined by fighting awards only.

\* Peerages by your own hand count as fighting awards

Best 2 of 3 (lower precedence chooses, higher precedence chooses. lower precedence chooses)

Matched weapons

No repeated weapons styles within each bout

Allowed styles (no weapons over 6'):

- Single-handed weapon and buckler (no bigger than 18" round)
- Two weapon (single-handed weapons only)
- Bastard sword (4' - 5')
- Great sword (over 5')
- Great axe (4' - 5')
- Polearm
- Spear
